Short description. Economist and expert in migration and public health: my research interests are mainly concentrated on the impact of mobility and migration in Europe. I am currently working as Research Fellow at Department of Social, Political and Cognitive Sciences at University of Siena (Italy) as a member of the [Inequality Lab](#) (*Laboratorio delle Diseguaglianze*). I am also migration expert at the *Migration Policies and International Protection Unit* of Caritas Italiana. I am Senior Advisor on Migration and Development for the [Agency for Peacebuilding](#).

For seven years I have worked at the *Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies* (RSCAS) of the European University Institute (EUI) as Research Fellow and Project Coordinator.
